

## THE BUNGALOWS, GALLIFORDTRY



### BIODIVERSITY ENHANCEMENT OVERVIEW

This social housing construction scheme involved the development of 52 new social homes for North East Derbyshire District Council and is scheduled to be completed in January 2015.

A number of biodiversity enhancement opportunities have been implemented, namely, the creation of a:

- Log pile invertebrate habitat using waste timbers through the pruning of site tree branches.
- Reptile hibernaculum using site won aggregates and construction materials.
- Bug hotel using waste skip pallets filled with site won construction materials.
- Bird table sourced from a local hardware store within 1 mile of the social housing scheme development; hence, also supporting the local economy.
- Rain garden from the output of a water butt attached to the construction site office with plants obtained from a local garden centre within 1 mile of the social housing scheme development; hence, also supporting the local economy.
