BIODIVERSITY ENHANCEMENT OVERVIEW

The project involved the construction of a new train station (Energlyn & Churchill Park) for the local community.

The project also comprises the following biodiversity enhancements:

- Biodiversity area established in the site compound during construction which included bird feeders, insect houses and flowering plants.
- Bird boxes were installed in trees around the site as mitigation due to de-vegetation works that were required in order to construct the new station.
- A community planting event was carried out with the local school as part of the landscaping work for the project. Seeds and bulbs were provided for children to plant and sow.
